

TOURNAMENT SERIES FAQ

When is the last day to register?

Registration for each tournament closes at 11:59pm on the Wednesday before the tournament.

Can I carry my child's clubs or help them during the tournament?

Parents and/or spectators are not allowed in any way, shape, or form to help the participant in playing the game. This includes carrying the bag, raking bunkers, club selection, and rules or scoring. Parents will be warned then asked to go back to clubhouse if this is violated.

Is there a trophy?

We award a first-place trophy and second & third place medals for each flight.

What happens if there is a tie?

Ties will be broken by a scorecard playoff. For 6-hole flights: last three holes cumulative score, if still tied, hole by hole scores starting with #4 through #6. If still tied it will be head-to-head score on the hardest hole. If still tied a coin-flip will be used to award winner. For 9-hole flights: Last six holes cumulative score, if still tied, last 3 holes cumulative score. If still tied, hole by hole scores starting with #7 through #9. If still tied it will be head-to-head score on the hardest hole. Still tied we will use a coin-flip.

When are tee times given?

Tee times and pairings will be sent out on Thursday afternoon/early evenings. They will also be published on the tournaments page.

What time should we arrive before tournament?

Participants are required to check-in at least 15 minutes prior to their tee time but can arrive an hour prior. Please respect the host course facilities when warming up. Range balls are included in the tournament registration fee.

Can my child play in a different flight?

All participants must play in the appropriate flight based on their birthday by **Sept 1**st, **2023** for the **2023** season. Pending approval by the Director of Programming, players may play below their set division but the results, aside from participation points, *will not* be credited toward Tour Championship qualification.

Are there certain qualifications to play in the Tournament Series?

We ask that participants be able to carry or use a push-cart for their bag and have basic knowledge of the game. Ability level is from beginner to advanced in all flights. Our expected outcome is not based on scores, but on knowledge of pace of play, rules, etiquette and scoring.

How long do the rounds generally take?

For the 6-hole rounds, we generally expect players to finish in 90 minutes from their tee time. For 9-hole rounds, we generally expect players to finish in 140 minutes or less from their tee time.

Who will answer Rules Questions on course?

For the Linksters and Futures division: Coaches will be with each group and will help with scoring and rules. For the Champions and Pro's division: Coaches will be roaming rules officials as well as designated players in each group to help go over rules within each grouping. Parents and/or spectators are not allowed to make rulings or player will be disqualified for receiving help.

How do you qualify for the Tour Championship?

Players can qualify for the Tour Championship based off overall standings of the last regular tournament before the Tour Championship. We send out invites to a decided amount of participants based on the number of active players in each division. (Last year we invited 12 Pros, 6 Champions, 9 Futures, and 6 Linksters based on division average but this changes year to year)
